Connection Partner (Job Description)

There are a few easy requirements.

1. Enjoy talking on the phone!
2. Attend an orientation/training session on Connection Ministries.
3. Ask God if this is the right ministry for you.
4. Complete and sign a Connection Partner Information Form.
5. Have a working email connection at home.
6. Have a printer hooked up to your computer.
7. Attend periodic Connection Partner training sessions.
8. Commit to faithfully fulfill the number of call assignments to which you have agreed to the best of your ability.
9. Call guest/visitor within the required timeframe.

You Control Your Involvement

ConnectionPower™ volunteers are safe from overload and are totally in control of their ministry involvement at all times.

1. Volunteers **set the number of calls** they are willing to make per week.
2. Volunteers can choose to accept a call assignment or **reject it guilt free!**
3. Volunteers **can log themselves out of call assignments** for a specified period of time due to busyness, travel or vacations.

Connection Partners tread where the heart of God resides - they represent a love initiative from the church to those who are seeking a new church home!
